Remember Nhu offers 24-7 prevention homes for children at risk of the sex trade and also assists other leaders in launching their own nonprofits to do the same. We are committed to meeting the physical, educational, emotional and spiritual needs of vulnerable children by showing them the love of God through indigenous house parents and helpers, or foster parents in countries where we do foster care.\*

Thanks to the support of people like you, we currently have over 100 homes in more than 15 countries and have prevented over 2,000 children from being sold.

## They Need Your Help

Too many of the world's children are vulnerable, orphaned, abandoned, or alone. Our children are identified by local members of their community, school teachers, social workers, police and by children already living in our homes.
